The bill includes Guy Clark, Townes Van Zandt, Billy Joe Shaver and Gary Nicholson, who has written songs for the likes of Aaron Neville, Lee Roy Parnell and B.B. King.

Nicholson also appears as a guest artist Sunday, when local rock and soul singer Jonell Mosser and her band, Enough Rope, close out Cheekwood's Sounds on the Ground concert series.
