Townes Van Zandt — Like Bob Dylan, he' a troubadour, forever writing noncommercial songs ("Pancho and Lefty," "If I Needed You") — that spring from his own life and imagination and what he sees of the world — and touring to sing them. He's a witty talker, one given to exaggeration, so his introductions to tunes range from hys terically funny nonsense to custard-sweet truths.
