DEAR DR. FOX: Our year-old Siamese cat comes into heat every three weeks. Our vet recommended that she have a spay of kittens, saying that she wouldn't come into heat so often. Well, we had her spayed, but she didn't get pregnant. What do we do now?

IT SEEMS irresponsible to not to control an animal's heat cycles by getting it spayed. There are too many unwanted kittens borned today, without creating more for "therapeutic" purposes. So far as I am aware, there is no evidence that after a pregnancy a cat will never again have repeated heat cycles. The best cure is to have your cat spayed.

DEAR DR. FOX: My three-year-old shepherd has pink fleshy-looking growths on both eyes. The growths originate from the corners of the eyelids and seem a little transparent. One eye is about one-third covered, the other eye a little less. What is wrong?

THESE "GROWTHS" are probably nothing more than your dog's "third eyelids." These can become enlarged because of a mild infection, or the eyelid can move out from the inner corner of the eye when the eye is irritated or when the dog is in poor condition. My guess is that you are noticing for the first time a natural structure that cats and dogs don't share with their owners.

DEAR DR. FOX: I have a 10-year-old small French poodle that persists in pulling out her hair, mostly near the middle of her back on the side. At first we suspected fleas, but we have checked many times and are certain there are none. This problem has persisted for a long time
